#### ALPACA POO TO SUPPORT ST WILFRID'S CHURCH

The Alpacas at Highfield Farm are supporting St Wilfrid's Church by producing organic feed for your garden or vegetable plot.

Our boys only eat grass, carrots and apples and their poo is great for your garden and can be dug straight in, no need to wait for it to rot down.

Alpaca manure is an excellent fertilizer for both outdoor and indoor plants. Along with providing your plants with a good organic



source of nutrients, alpaca manure is an excellent soil conditioner and mulch, allowing your soil to retain more moisture. It is relatively odour free and easy to spread and work with. It can be used "as-is" or made into a "tea" (added to your watering can) before giving to plants.
