The beautiful light and colour of the East Yorkshire Coast comes to Burton Constable Hall. From Spurn Point to Bempton, Filey and beyond, a new exhibition of paintings by Christopher Heald at Burton Constable Hall, will take you on a tour of the East Yorkshire Coast.

Artist Christopher Heald, has created this series of paintings in the last six months especially for this Burton Constable show. "The East Yorkshire coast has been such an inspiration for my work, the landscape is so varied, and gives me lots to contend with. Above all, I'm interested in colour, and how the light and atmosphere create and change those colours and give a landscape it's life.

Christopher has been based in East Yorkshire for a couple of years now. "Everyone I've met has shown me such support, whether it's been on a windswept coastal path, or a warm Summer evening at Spurn Point. I'm always discovering great new places, Halsham Waterside is a favourite for a wonderful coffee and cake after a painting trip. I feel proud to be in this community and creating pictures that hopefully can be enjoyed."

Christopher has exhibited in the U.K. and France, and has paintings in private collections in Europe, Canada and Hong Kong. He is passionate about painting and influenced by ways to represent what he sees. "I don't just paint the scene in front of me, I paint the effect that the weather, light and atmosphere has on that scene. The two most prominent places that feature in this show are Flamborough and Bempton. I love painting the sea, but also the landscape there, has many different textures and surfaces. The cliffs show all the colours that are reflected from neighbouring elements, what a challenge for a painter!"

"I'm very proud to be exhibiting these paintings at Burton Constable Hall. It's a lovely space in beautiful surroundings, and the team there have been so generous with their time and help."

TOXOCARIASIS – health risk to children!

Toxocariasis is a rare infection caused by roundworm parasites. Humans can catch it from handling soil or sand contaminated with infected animal faeces.

Roundworm parasites are most commonly found in cats, dogs and foxes, and usually affect young children under the age of 10 years. This is because children are more likely to come into contact with contaminated soil when they play and put their hands in their mouths. However, cases have been reported in people of all ages.

As reported in the February issue of the Beacon, it has been noticed that dog fouling on the playing fields at Ottringham is still happening. Please be aware of the danger to children who are playing on this area and keep your dogs under close control at all times.

Please use the bags from the doggie bag dispensers in the village and help to keep the pavements in our village clean.
