My name is Ruth Thompson and I live in Halsham and would like to promote my children's book 'The Boys with Big Ideas'.

I am a self published author and wrote this book a few years ago for my daughter based on stories I used to tell her at bedtime. I published my first book after the birth of my second child who came 11 weeks early with Meningitis.

It was a hectic time running backwards and forwards to NICU but I managed to promote and sell my books at local schools and craft fairs in between, it gave me something positive to think about. I also sold copies to Hedon Library and a Hessle Book shop as well as advertising it on Amazon.

I work at Preston Primary School and most of the children have now read the book. I ask them for feedback and it is always really positive. I feel strongly that children get so much benefit from reading so it is great when they say they enjoy it.

I am currently working on the second book featuring the same three characters and hope to finish it shortly.

Chris at Halsham Waterside has agreed to stock my book and we are doing a Book Signing and Promotion in time for Christmas on Saturday 10 November between 10.00 -11.00am.

The books retail at £6. Up till Christmas I am going to donate £1 from every book sold to the Hull Neonatal baby care unit as they saved my little boys life.
